## PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

TO: Resident at 38220 Buford Ave. Dade City, FL 33525

The Florida Department of Transportation hit a water main during normal construction process on the US 98 Bypass on Wednesday May 1, 2024.

Therefore, as a precaution, we advise that all used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, or washing dishes be boiled. A rolling boil of one minute would be sufficient. As an alternative, bottled water may be used.

The "Precautionary Boil Water Notice" will remain in effect until the water main break has been repaired and The City of Dade City has conducted water testing for two consecutive days. Once a bacteriological survey shows that the water is safe to drink, the City will then rescind the Precautionary Boil Water Notice and residents will be notified.
